Thriving against all odds

We are really excited that Richard McCann will be joining us on **Tuesday 11 June as a Guest Speaker** at the Conference. He will inspire us with his transformative story from heartbreaking childhood to captivating audiences worldwide with over 3,000 keynote presentations.

Richard's journey is a profound narrative of overcoming adversity, marked by an extraordinarily challenging upbringing. In 2004, Richard authored a book detailing his life experiences, which not only became a No.1 bestseller but also ranked as the 5th bestselling non-fiction book in the UK for 2005. His story has gained widespread recognition, featured on Netflix and portrayed through both his childhood and adulthood in the impactful ITV drama 'The Long Shadow.'

Richard McCann's story is not just about the challenges he faced but about the resilience and determination to transform his life. His presentations are memorable leaving a lasting impression. Richard's story is an unforgettable testament to the human spirit's capacity to triumph over adversity.

Behind the stiff upper lip and glorious wit Sir Ranulph is one of the most inspiring leaders you could ever encounter.


Sir Ranulph, commonly known as 'Ran', was the first man to reach both poles by surface travel, and the first to cross Antarctica unsupported. He is also the oldest Briton to climb Everest. In 2003, only 3½ months after suffering a massive heart attack and double bypass operation, he ran 7 marathons on 7 continents in 7 days. He also ran an ultramarathon in the Sahara. He undertook the first expedition to attempt to cross the Antarctic continent on foot during the southern winter, at temperatures of minus 90C; but sadly, frostbite forced his withdrawal. Despite the setback, Ran believes that 'if you are lucky enough to be able to walk without a crutch, you might as well go for it.'

In 1993 he was awarded an OBE for 'human endeavour and charitable services'; through his expeditions, Ran has raised large amounts for charities.

Ran is also a prolific writer with 23 books to his name, including the 1991 UK bestseller The Feather Men, and in 2003 the top selling biography of Captain Scott. In 2011 The Feather Men was released as a major motion picture 'Killer Elite' starring Robert De Niro.

Sir Ranulph will inspire us with his stories of overcoming adversity, understanding risk and choosing the best path to literally...stay alive; it's all in a day's work for Ran!
